# Dress a Girl is Fourteen Years Old! October 11th is International Day of the Girl Child!

In 2009 when my sister Joan and I took pillowcases to Uganda to teach women to make dresses from pillowcases we had no idea of what God was going to do. Pictured above are the very first dresses made from those pillowcases. The goal was to teach women in Uganda to make dresses for their daughters, nieces and granddaughters.

In October, 2009 we sent an experimental box of fifty dresses with a group traveling to Honduras. When we received pictures back we were all hooked! I said: "We must be Dress a Girl Around the World!" I threw up a website and God took over! Since then we have ambassadors making and distributing dresses all over the world and have recorded over 3,000,000 dresses to over 90 countries!!!

I personally have had the privilege of physically dressing girls in Uganda, Rwanda, Guatemala, Chile, Peru, Romania, Fiji, Jordan, Cambodia, India, Haiti, The Philippines, and throughout the USA.

Thank you to everyone who has made dresses, distributed dresses and contributed to this ministry through prayer and finances! Together we are dressing the world!



### DRESS A GIRL SEAMSTRESS/AUTHOR!





Award winning author C.A. Simonson sews for Dress a Girl in her spare time. She states: "I got involved after first seeing the movie, Sound of Freedom. It left me with the feeling of 'I've got to - want to - do something, but what can I do?'

Soon afterward, our church had a senior citizens meeting where missionaries John and Judy Hiede (50 Plus Ministries/SW Missouri) told about their involvement in Dress a Girl. They showed a dress made from a man's shirt and how easy it was to become involved. Right then and there I knew what I could do. I was given an assignment: I could sew. I love to sew. I looked up the dressagirlaroundtheworld.com site and found the information for my SW Missouri ambassador and contacted her, Sue Cavness.

And that's how it started. She sent me kits around the first of August. Since then, I've made 20 dresses and 10 pairs of shorts - with many more to come. It's been a great inspiration and a good feeling of accomplishment --plus feeling like I'm actually 'doing something' to help these little girls feel worth - maybe even empowerment.

Of her book, Candy tells me: "This book actually came from a dream. Then, the more I researched, it compelled me to write Rosie's story and tell how one girl's life can be changed through compassion and the love of God. Although this was fiction, it speaks of so many girls' lives in our world."

I ordered Candy's book and enjoyed it so much I thought you may want to read it as well.

Here's the synopsis: Unwanted. Unloved. Broken and scarred. "No man wants a cripple," she was told, "and you're damaged goods." But she never dreamed she'd be thrown away. There was only one thing she could do..."Runaway" is a fictional account that captures the plight of runaways, child abuse, and foster care in America. It's a message of hope and faith when all else seems lost. A throwaway to one, a child prodigy to another - it's all in the perspective.

People all over the world have participated during the month of September and we are anticipating huge numbers of dresses as they have been flooding Mari's post office as well as ambassadors around the world!



# ANGEL FOOD/CHEESECAKE RECIPE!







#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1 Angel food Cake—cooled and cut into three layers
- 1 tub of cheese cake no bake filling (Walmart has the lowest price)

Fruit—strawberries, raspberries, blueberries, etc.

1 Tub cool whip

#### Assemble:

Cover the bottom layer of cake with cheesecake filling.

Add fruit of your choice. I used sliced strawberries and blueberries.

Place the middle layer next and repeat the process.

Mix the remaining cheesecake filling and the tub of cool whip.

Place the top layer and cover the entire cake with the cool whip/ cheesecake mixture. Add fruit and enjoy!

I must warn you that if you are serving this to guests you should have a second one made and handy in your refrigerator because this cake goes quickly.
