Friends, I am sorry to tell you about the passing of one of our most beloved and faithful Dress a Girl servants, **Sara Jane Tanner**, on October 29, 2025. Those of you who attended our SewFests in the past know what a steady presence she was. Sara was one of the ones who quietly labeled the dresses that were turned in at the SewFests. She made over 1,000 dresses through the years and I estimate just as many flat dolls. I also believe that her dresses have been in most all of the batches of dresses sent to the 54 countries around the world we have reached. How she loved sewing for Dress a Girl! She endured many years of physical pain yet stayed faithful, serving all the way to the end. Sara did not want a public memorial service but her two daughters will be honoring her in a private family ceremony at Sara's request. Oh, how we will miss her! Will you stop and say a prayer thanking God for this life well-lived?

Finding Meaning in a Messy World By Julie A. Tenenbaum

"To do what you love, and feel that it matters...how could anything be more fun?" I read this quote by Katharine Graham (who published the Washington Post for almost thirty years) many years ago, and it has rung true for me ever since. Feeling that what you do matters is much more important than just being fun, however. It gives direction and a sense of purpose to the minutes and hours of your life. It gives your life meaning.

For the past three years, I have made dresses for Dress A Girl Around the World, a program of Hope 4 Women International. Founded in Uganda in 2009, its goal is to give new, hand-sewn dresses to vulnerable girls who live in poverty. Each dress—while being a practical gift that thrills the heart of a little girl who may never have received such a thing—is much more than an item of clothing. The intention is to help her feel loved and give her a sense of self-worth.

There's another goal of the project. The sad truth is, these girls are extremely vulnerable to child trafficking. No matter where in the world they live, they can easily be snatched away from their family and community by predators. The DressAGirl label on the front of each dress announces to would-be predators that this little girl is a member of a community and would be missed if she suddenly disappeared.

When I heard about this project through a YouTube video, I immediately wanted to use my sewing skills to help. I found the local contact person and volunteered my services. Now whenever I'm not working, I sew dresses. I am one of a group of women who do the same. My "ambassador" distributes some dresses locally to nonprofit organizations that work with those in need, and she gives others to travelers to hand-deliver them to villages as far away as Central America, Africa, and South Asia.

The need is unending. I know my contributions are a drop in the bucket compared to the number of girls in the world who live in desperate circumstances. But I believe everyone wants to be part of something larger than themselves, and for me, this is it. This is how I help create a better world. This is what keeps me going when I feel overwhelmed by the direction my own country is taking. I think of Mother Teresa's words:

"Not all of us cando great things. But we can do small things with great love."
