


Belt Loop Pocket

- Use the pattern to cut two belt loop pockets on the fold.
- With right sides folded together, stitch around the raw edges using a 1/2" seam. Leave a 1 1/2" opening at the bottom for turning.
- Trim all corners being careful not to cut too close to the stitching.
- Turn pockets right side out and iron
- Place pocket on front piece of your dress aligning the waist mark on the pattern with the appropriate size measurements. The pockets should be placed equal distance from the sides (about 2-3") and aligned vertically to match.



- Stitch across the top of the pocket, stitch across the waist mark making a loop for a sash belt. Then stitch around the rest of the pocket leaving an opening at the angle for placing hands.

Sash belt

- Make a sash belt 1 1/2" wide and approximately 80-85" long. I just use my rotary cutter and cut (2) 3" strips from a folded standard 42" wide piece of coordinating fabric and sew them together at the ends to make 84".
- Fold the 3" wide fabric in half lengthwise, right sides together and stitch around the three sides of the raw edges. Leave an opening near the middle to be able to turn the belt right side out. (I like to give each end a slight angle to create a pointed end when tying.)
